The Women in Aerospace (WIA) is a network devoted to expanding women's opportunities for leadership and increasing their visibility in the aerospace community. Our membership, women and men, shares an interest in a broad spectrum of aerospace issues, including human space flight, aviation, remote sensing, satellite communications, robotic space exploration, and the policy issues surrounding these fields.

2009 - WIA Europe: the extension of this network to a global organization



2010 - WIA Canada was created



2011 - WIA Africa was created



2017 - WIA Mexico and Japan were created

 - up from 30.2 per cent in 2018 and just 12.5 per cent in 2011.
